## THE INSTITUTE

## BACKGROUND

As per the guidelines GoI for operationalisation of certificate Course on “Insecticides Management” for Insecticides Dealers/Distributors (G.S.R. 07 (E) dated 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2020, the National Institute of Plant Health Management (NIPHM), Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare (MoA&FE) has been entrusted the role of coordinator for the 72 hours (12 weeks) certificate course for insecticides dealers & distributors and to equip them to acquire a professional competency on pesticides & pest management and associated advisory services thereof. NIPHM-MoA & FW has recognized IIPM-Bengaluru as a Nodal Training Institute (NTI) for conducting the proposed training programmes for Insecticide Dealers/Distributors.

## OBJECTIVE

- ✓ To impart the basic technical knowledge on pesticides and pest management to the insecticides dealers and distributors.
- ✓ To provide knowledge about the rules and laws governing the insecticides.



## WHO SHOULD ENROLL

The course is open to all the practicing insecticides dealers who are yet to comply the requirement of essential qualification, as per notification No. GSR 106 (E) dated 01.02.2017 issued under the insecticides Rules, 1971.



## COURSE FEE

The insecticides dealers program fee is Rs.7,600/- per candidate. (non-residential)

## CURRICULUM

The curriculum consisting of theory, practical and field visit. The coverage of curriculum content shall be based on the local needs and relevance.

## ATTENDANCE REQUIRMENTS

Each candidate is required to fulfil a minimum of 80% of attendance both in theory and field visit for appearing the final exam.
