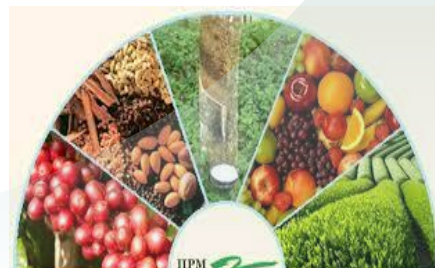


The Institute
