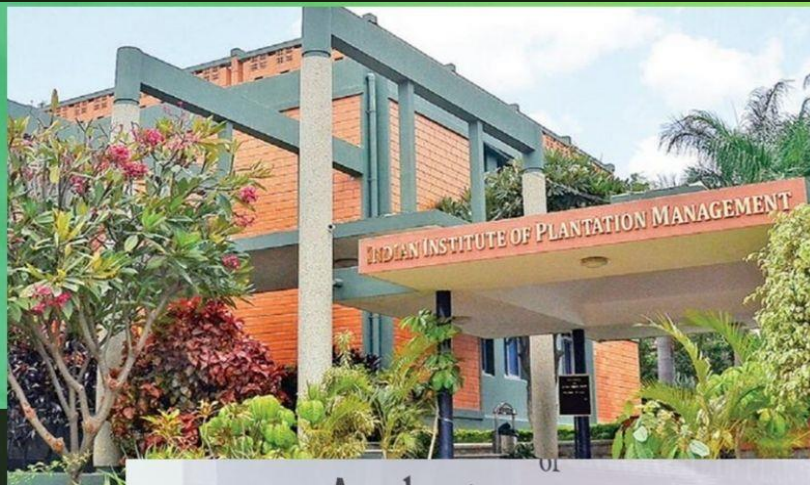
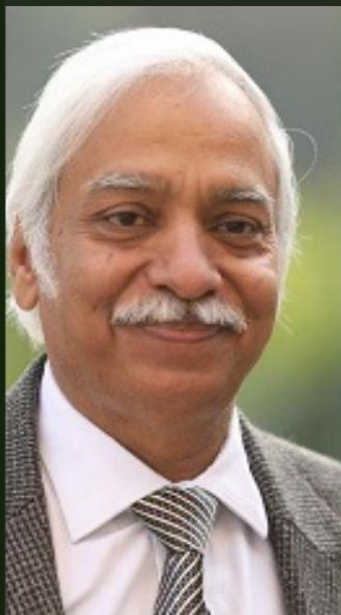

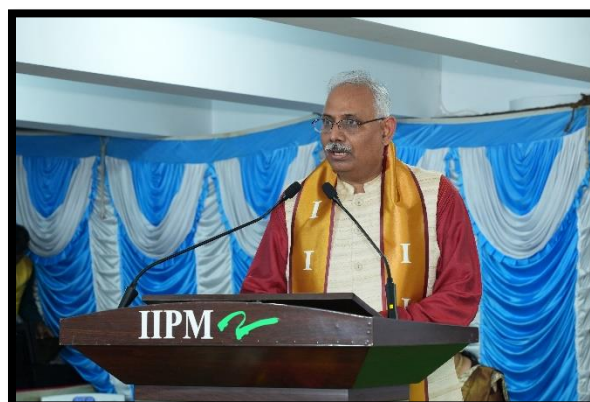


CONVOCATION
