Coffee Board :

IIPMB undertook a study to evaluate the Integrated Coffee Development Project (ICDP) implemented by the Coffee Board during the plan period 2024–25 to 2025–26. The research team comprised of Dr. John Mano Raj. S, Prof. Prof. Manmohan Yadav, Dr. Venkateswaran. K, Dr. Dinesh Jain & Dr. Shilpa S Kokatnur. The ICDP aimed to enhance the productivity, quality, and sustainability of coffee cultivation through the interventions such as replantation, irrigation, farm mechanization, pest and disease management, and infrastructure development. The evaluation assessed the effectiveness of these interventions, with particular emphasis on their impact on small coffee growers, by analyzing stakeholder feedback, field-level experiences, and key performance indicators. The study sought to identify strengths, gaps, and opportunities for policy improvement to ensure that the scheme remained relevant, inclusive, and responsive to the evolving needs of India's coffee sector.

Spices Board :

IIPMB conducted an independent evaluation of the Sustainability in Spice Sector through Progressive Innovative Collaborative Interventions for Export Development (SPICED) Scheme implemented by the Spices Board of India during the period 2023–24 to 2025–26. The research team comprised of Dr. John Mano Raj S, Dr. Prakash K C, Dr. Archana Thulaseedharan, Dr. Lavanya B T, and Dr. Naveen B R. The evaluation examined the design, implementation, and outcomes of the scheme's multi-component interventions covering productivity enhancement, post-harvest quality upgradation, technological interventions, research and development, capacity building, market expansion, and trade promotion. Using a combination of primary and secondary data, stakeholder consultations, and performance indicators, the study assessed effectiveness, inclusiveness, and operational efficiency, with particular emphasis on small and marginal farmers, FPOs, SC/ST groups, women stakeholders, MSMEs, and the North Eastern Region. The evaluation identified key achievements, implementation challenges, and evidence-based recommendations to strengthen policy coherence, delivery mechanisms, and the long-term sustainability of the Indian spice sector.

**Rubber Board :**

IIPMB undertook an independent evaluation of the Sustainable and Inclusive Development of the Natural Rubber Sector (SID-NR) Scheme implemented by the Rubber Board during the period 2023–24 to 2025–26. The research team comprised of Dr. John Mano Raj S, Dr. Narendran.



K, Dr. Parvathi Jayaprakash and Dr. Shreya Pal. The evaluation examined the design, implementation, and outcomes of integrated interventions covering plantation development, research, technology adoption, processing and marketing support, human resource development, and institutional strengthening. Special emphasis was placed on assessing the scheme's effectiveness in improving productivity, sustainability, and the

livelihood of small rubber growers and allied stakeholders across traditional and non-traditional regions. Using field surveys, stakeholder consultations, and performance indicators, the study identified key achievements, implementation gaps, and emerging challenges, and provided evidence-based recommendations to enhance policy effectiveness, inclusivity, and long-term sectoral resilience.

Tea Board

IIPMB undertook an independent evaluation of the Tea Development and Promotion Scheme (TDPS) implemented by the Tea Board under the Department of Commerce during 2023–24 to 2025–26. The research team comprised of Dr. John Mano Raj S, Dr. Venkateswaran. K, Dr. Parvathi Jayaprakash and Dr. Shreya Pal. The evaluation assessed scheme design, implementation processes, and early outcomes across integrated components including plantation development and quality upgradation, market promotion and export support, technological intervention, research and development, welfare and capacity building, and institutional establishment. It examined the scheme's effectiveness in addressing structural challenges such as ageing plantations, productivity stagnation, quality and compliance requirements, market access constraints, digital gaps, and socio-economic vulnerabilities of tea workers and small growers. Using a mixed-method approach involving secondary data analysis, field surveys, stakeholder consultations, focus group discussions, and results-based frameworks, the study identified key achievements, regional variations, and implementation bottlenecks. The TDPS was found to be strategically relevant and aligned with national priorities on sustainability, Digital India, export competitiveness, and the Viksit Bharat 2047 vision. While measurable impacts are limited due to early implementation, the evaluation offers evidence-based recommendations to improve inclusiveness, simplify procedures, strengthen outcome orientation, scale technology and research interventions, and enhance institutional efficiency to ensure long-term effectiveness and global competitiveness of the Indian tea sector.




